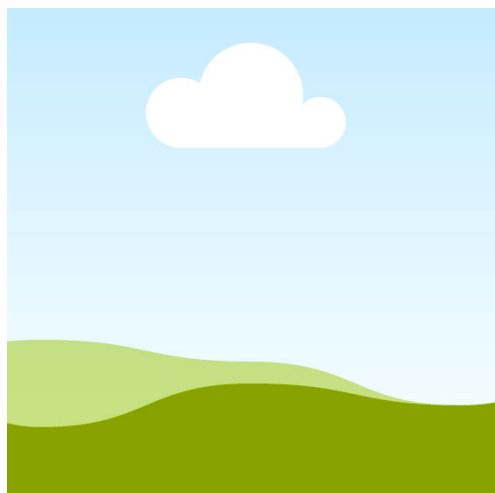




SANDRA FERRIN
