Representative Matters

- Obtained summary judgment on behalf of a vehicle rental company in a personal injury lawsuit arising from a motor vehicle accident involving a rented vehicle. Successfully argued that the plaintiff's vicarious liability claims were barred by the federal Graves Amendment, resulting in the dismissal of all claims against the client and its complete removal from the litigation.
- Successfully obtained summary judgment for a non-profit organization in a premises liability case stemming from an alleged fall on exterior stairs at a public school. By presenting key contractual documents, an executive affidavit, and co-defendant admissions, established that the client lacked possession or control of the area and had no legal duty to the plaintiff.
- Secured affirmance on appeal of dismissal of suit against Vermont-based attorney for lack of personal jurisdiction to be subject to suit in Connecticut.
- Obtained summary judgment on behalf of a property owner in a toxic black mold case brought by a former tenant.
